SELF GUIDED EXHIBIT

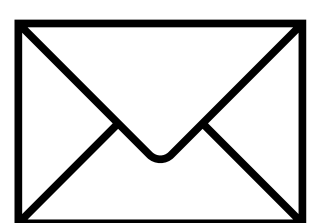
On September 19, 2023, the County of San Mateo, with the San Mateo County Transportation Authority and Caltrans, hosted a public open house and presentation on the Moss Beach SR 1 Congestion and Safety Improvements Project. The team provided an overview of the project's background, needs, and goals; described the project approval process; shared preliminary findings from the traffic and environmental review; presented design concepts for the project area; and described next steps.

Improvements may include:

- Pedestrian Walkways
- High-visibility Pedestrian Crosswalks
- Multimodal Bicycle and Pedestrian Trail
- Bike Lanes
- Bus Stop Improvements
- Roundabouts and/or Traffic Signals
- Dedicated Turn Lanes
- Raised Median
