### THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS HAS PROVIDED RESPONSES (R) TO THE QUESTIONS BELOW

- Q1. Please let us know if there is a good faith effort required for this project? If so what type of disadvantaged business enterprise are we looking for? DBE, SBE, LBE, MBE, WBE, DVBE, OB)?
- R1. Yes, there is a good faith effort (GFE) required for the project. The requirements of the GFE are included in the project specifications in section 7-0.16 and Federal Requirements Page 15. We are requiring "Small and Minority Business, Women's Business Enterprise, and Labor Surplus Firms" to be solicited for potential sub-contracting work on the project.
- Q2. Please confirm if we are only required to attend one of the mandatory pre-bid meetings and the correct address where to go for the meeting
- R2. You are only required to attend one of the meetings. Your firm will need to sign in at the pre-bid meeting to confirm attendance and bids will not be accepted from firms who do not attend at least one pre-bid meeting.
- Q3. What is your anticipated NTP, schedule
- R3. The County will work with the Contractor who is awarded the contract on a mutually agreed upon start date. However, the County's goal is to complete the project as soon as possible and would like to issue the Notice to Proceed (NTP) in July of 2019.
- Q4. Any pending litigation associated with the mudslide?
- *R4.* The County is not aware of any pending litigation related to the mudslide.
- Q5. Section 1 on the Specifications makes reference to the Standard Specifications of the State of California, Department of Transportation but it does not state which year of the Standard Specifications we are to look at; is it the 2010, 2015 or 2018 Standard Specs?
- R5. The Contractor shall use the 2006 version of the Caltrans Standard Specifications for this project. Please refer to page 3 of the specifications "Section 2-1 Plans and Specifications."
