Thank you so much for sending the biological reports over. I have reviewed them, and have no comments.

In addition, I spoke with Bob today about the action items from last week. He said he would try to get them all done by the time I arrive onsite tomorrow. He is concerned about the amount of room between the trees on Lot 9 and the retaining wall on the West side of the property. He told me that the retaining wall appears to be located beneath the drip line of the trees, which is why he removed the orange snow fencing. I told him that he needed to put the tree protection fencing back up to protect the trees during all activities, but I will report back to you tomorrow after my inspection.
